Dear Superintendent:

This **2008 Council/NYSATA Student Art Exhibit** will be held at THE COUNCIL'S Fall Conference, *Connecting Quality Curriculum to Manage Success*, at the Saratoga Hotel & Conference Center, Saratoga Springs, NY, October 5-7, 2008.

Last year the co-sponsored **Council/NYSATA Student Art Exhibit** was held during THE COUNCIL'S 2007 Fall Conference and received enthusiastic support. Over 74 school districts representing 136 schools participated in a display of almost 400 exemplary art pieces. This year, with your participation, we hope to surpass those numbers!

As President of THE COUNCIL, along with Ernest Savaglio, the Jericho UFSD Curriculum Associate for Fine Arts and NYSATA Coordinator, we ask you to share this invitation with your K-12 art educators and art administrators in all of your district schools. Let them know that you support this endeavor and your district's art program.

Exhibit Guidelines

1. **Registration Fee:** \$20 *per school*; check payable to **NYSATA Region 10**; fee applied toward postage and handling costs.
2. **Deadline:** All artwork should be received no later than **July 30, 2008**. (Address below.)
3. **Submit:** Limit (3) works *per school* that are two dimensional only and no larger than 24" x 30" (including mat).
4. **Mat or Mount** work on light weight board. Mat, oak tag or Bristol board is preferred. Please no colored paper or foam core; wood frames or glass. Plexiglass is acceptable.
5. **Label on Back of Artwork** "typed" to read as follows:
 - County and NYSATA REGION NUMBER (see below)
 - School District w/address
 - Name of School w/address


