## Program Details



Dr. Michael Fullan is Professor Emeritus of the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education at the University of Toronto. Recognized as a worldwide authority on educational reform, Dr. Fullan is engaged in training, consulting, and evaluating change projects around the world and his books have been published in many languages.

Dr. Fullan is currently Special Advisor to the Premier and Minister of Education in Ontario. He holds Honorary Doctorates from the University of Edinburgh, Scotland and from Nipissing University in Canada. His book, *Leading in a Culture of Change* was awarded the 2002 Book of the Year Award by the National Staff Development Council and *Breakthrough* (with Peter Hill and Carmel Crevola) won the 2006 Book of the Year Award from the American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education. *Turnaround Leadership in Higher Education* (with Geoff Scott) won the Bellwether Book Award in 2009, and *Change Wars* (with Andy Hargreaves) was awarded the 2009 Book of the Year by Learning Forward.

**This workshop will focus on leadership at the school, district and state levels that causes improvement in capacity and, in turn, improvement in student achievement. Case examples will be provided.**
