

GETTING AHEAD OF THE GAME IN NEW YORK STATE

Complying with the New APPR Requirements



The new APPR regulations are arriving fast, with tight design and implementation timelines, putting enormous pressure on school districts to revise their systems to be compatible with the new requirements.

This two-day session will provide concrete suggestions for complying with many of the requirements for evaluation systems, and for training and certifying lead evaluators. The workshop will offer suggestions of approaches for district leadership teams to incorporate into their systems for documenting student growth, but is primarily designed to provide guidance on the portion of the APPR requirements related to teacher practices.

Participants can expect to meet the following objectives:

1. Understand the characteristics of an evaluation system that both ensures effective teaching and promotes teacher learning;
2. Identify alternatives to standardized tests for documenting student growth;
3. Understand the design steps for an evaluation system;
4. Prepare a draft evaluation system for the district;
5. Make a plan for training and certifying lead evaluators; and
6. Become familiar with online resources to assist with observation and evaluation.
