RE: Procedures for Election of 2011-2012 Officers

I am writing to advise you of opportunities to seek statewide leadership roles in THE COUNCIL. THE COUNCIL'S annual election of officers will be conducted between May 1 and May 15. If necessary, a run-off election will be conducted between May 15 and June 15.

At our recent Winter Institute, the membership approved an amendment to THE COUNCIL'S by-laws dividing the position of Vice President/Treasurer. Accordingly, three positions will be on the ballot this year:

- President-Elect
- Vice President
- Treasurer

Under the provisions of THE COUNCIL'S Constitution, Section 801, subdivision 1, the incumbent Vice President/Treasurer James Langlois (Superintendent of Putnam-Northern Westchester BOCES) will automatically be listed on the ballot as a candidate for President-Elect.

Completing the leadership slate for 2011-2012 will be Marilyn Terranova, Superintendent of Eastchester, who will become President and Robert Christmann, Superintendent of Grand Island, who will become Past President.

Petitions to nominate candidates may be filed for any of the three offices. In order to be nominated, petitions need to be signed by 35 active members of The Council. Please note that facsimiles of signed nominating petitions will not be accepted. Also, only active members whose dues are paid on schedule may sign nominating petitions and vote in the election. Further, according to THE COUNCIL'S by-laws, duplicate signatures for the same office are not permitted.
