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## WINDSOR SUPERINTENDENT DR. JASON A. ANDREWS NAMED 2019 NEW YORK STATE SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT OF THE YEAR

Dr. Andrews currently serves on the Executive Committee for the New York State Council of School Superintendents, the State Education Commissioner's Advisory Council, and the National Center for Educational Research and Technology National Board and is a charter member of the Institute for Innovation.

He also consults with districts across the country regarding Professional Learning Communities, strategic planning, and preventing bullying and harassment.

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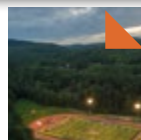


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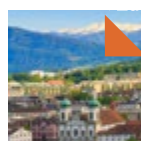
